

Free Income Tax Assistance

If you earn up to \$54,000, the Kenosha County VITA program can prepare your basic tax returns for Free!



Required to bring:

- ⇒ Valid photo ID (self & spouse)
- ⇒ Social Security Cards, ITIN Cards and birth dates for everyone on the return
- ⇒ Last year's Federal and State tax returns
- ⇒ Wage and earning statement (s), W-2, W-2G or 1099, 1099-R, etc.
- ⇒ Interest & dividend statements
- ⇒ Unemployment compensation (1099-G)
- ⇒ Proof of bank account and routing information or blank check
- ⇒ Healthcare Insurance 1095-A, B or C statement or exemption certificate

And, if you have

- ⇒ Childcare expenses with provider's address and Social Security Number or EIN number
- ⇒ 2018 Rent certificate signed by Landlord -or- property tax bill
- ⇒ Proof of disability (VA/Social Security/physician) or income when filing a Homestead Only return
- ⇒ Mortgage statement
- ⇒ All IRS or Wisconsin Department of Revenue notices
- ⇒ 1098T College tuition & student loan interest and expenses
- ⇒ Alimony paid or received
