

Reading Prompts

The prompts below can be used to prompt a child when they are stuck on a tricky word. If you try a few prompts and the child still does not get the word, you may simply tell the word to the child.

What would make sense?	What would sound right?	What would look right?
Start again. Reread from the beginning of the sentence.	Look at the pictures.	Get your mouth ready to say the first sound.
Skip the word, read on and then go back.	Look for little words inside big words. standing	Say the sounds slowly Slide the sounds together.
Look for parts you know. * ag	Flip the vowel sounds.	Where have I seen that word before?
