- 2 out of 3** third graders cannot read proficiently
- 2nd** Kenosha County is ranked #2 in the state for victimization
- 3** The top 3 needs in Kenosha County, as reported by calls to 211, are: housing, substance use disorder assistance, and food pantries
- 21st** Kenosha County is ranked #21 in the state for financial hardship among all 72 WI counties
- almost 68K** households struggle to afford the basics
- half** of renters in Kenosha are cost-burdened, paying 30% or more of their monthly income in rent

OUR COMMUNITY-DRIVEN SOLUTIONS

- Since 1923, United Way of Kenosha County has brought our community together to serve those who need help the most.
