

Through the Imagination Library, UWKC helps ensure that all children have books at home, regardless of the environment in which they grow up in. For the cost of \$30 per year, you can help provide a child in Kenosha County with up to 12 free books – at no cost to their family.

\$15,000\* annually for 5 years

In one year, your donation will uarantee free books for 500 children, and after five years — 2,500 kids. That's the impact of \$75,000!





Readers Are Leaders (RAL) provides reading support to students who need it most by pairing volunteer tutors with students at participating schools. **RAL currently mobilizes roughly 60 tutors who read weekly with close to 75 students.** Sponsoring Readers Are Leaders includes recognition in training materials, volunteer communications, and other promotional materials and supports bridging literacy gaps in Kenosha.
